

Ministry of Education and Culture Launches Emancipated Learning Episode 5: Teacher Leader

"Teacher Leader as an Initiator of Indonesian Education Transformation"

Jakarta, Kemendikbud --- The Ministry of Education and Culture (Kemendikbud) today, Friday (03/07) launched Emancipated Learning Episode 5: Teacher Leader, virtually attended by Minister of Education and Culture Nadiem Anwar Makarim, accompanied by the General Director of Teachers and Education Personnel (GTK) Iwan Syahril. The launching event was also attended by Governors, Regents/Mayors, Heads of Provincial and Regency/City Education Offices, Teacher Professional Organizations/Associations, Teachers, Principals, School Supervisors, and Education Personnel throughout Indonesia.

"The Teacher Leader, as an initiator of the transformation of Indonesian education, is expected to be able to support student growth and development holistically so that they become Pancasila Students, become coaches or mentors for other teachers for student-centered learning, as well as become role models and agents of transformation for the education ecosystem," said the Minister of Education and Culture.

The direction of the Teacher Leader program focuses on pedagogy, along with student-centered and holistic development, training that emphasizes instructional leadership through on-the-job coaching, formative and development-based approaches, and collaboration with the holistic school approach. The new school leadership training begins with the recruitment of prospective Teacher Leaders. Furthermore, Teacher Leader training was carried out by attending workshops in the first phase and mentoring in the second phase. "Prepare yourself and prepare the best teachers in your school to join as Teacher Leaders," said the Minister of Education and Culture.

The General Director of GTK, Iwan Syahril, explained the impact and the evidence-based Teacher Leader education and assessment process. "The leadership process is very important, and in this leadership development process, we reflect on various studies and approaches to andragogy or adult learning that we must focus more on the job learning. That is, the relevant and contextual learning that will bring the best impact," said Iwan.

There are three training modules. First Packet is Paradigm and The Teacher Leaders Vision with material reflecting the Indonesian educational philosophy - Ki Hadjar Dewantara, the values and vision of the Teacher Leader, and building a positive culture in the School. The Second Package is Student-Based Learning Practices with differentiated learning materials, social and emotional learning, and coaching. The Third Package is Learning Leadership in Learning in School Development which contains material on decision-making as learning leaders, leaders in resource management, and managing school programs that impact the students.

Through the vision of Emancipated Learning, Teacher Leaders is expecting to be able to produce as many transformational agents in the education ecosystem as possible that can produce globally competent students with Pancasila characters, able to encourage the transformation of Indonesian education, encourage the improvement of student academic achievement, teach

creatively, and develop themselves actively. Teacher Leaders can play more roles than the current teachers.

Iwan added that the Teacher Leader program is a form of collaboration from all parties with the main focus on students. "Teacher Leaders must be able to inspire them to continue learning and exploring their potential and be role models for students. Let's strengthen collaboration for Indonesian children towards a better quality of education," he said.

To participate, the following are the stages of the Teacher Leader Program:

- 13 July 2020: recruitment information for prospective participants.
- 13 July until 22 July 2020: registration of prospective participants through the website sekolah.penggerak.kemdikbud.go.id/gurupenggerak.
- 23 July until 30 July 2020: Phase 1 selection for administration, biodata, scholastic aptitude tests, essays, and case study of learning.
- 24 until 28 August 2020: announcement of stage 1 selection results and scheduling of stage 2 selection.
- 31 August until 16 September 2020: Stage 2 selection for teaching simulation and interview.
- 19 September 2020: announcement of The Teacher Leader candidates.
- 5 October 2020 until 31 August 2021: The Teacher Leader education.
- September 15, 2021: announcement of the results of the appointment of Teacher Leader.

Previously, the Ministry of Education and Culture launched 4 Episodes of Emancipated Learning. In Episode 1, Emancipated Learning changed the National Examination into a minimum competency assessment and character survey, removed the National Standard School Examination, simplified the learning implementation plan, and adjusted the quota for admission of new students based on zoning.

Emancipated Learning 2: Independent Campus provides convenience in the implementation of learning in universities, Emancipated Learning 3: Changes in the School Operational Assistance Mechanism (BOS) for the fiscal year 2020, and Emancipated Learning 4: Mobilizing Organization Program.
